**Schedule 23 Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme**

**ASSISTANCE ESTABLISHMENT NOTICE**

In accordance with Part 2 of Schedule 23 the Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme is established for the disaster event: Northern and Central Queensland Monsoon and Flooding, 20 December 2022 – March 2023

Primary producers, small businesses and non-profit organisations are the entities eligible for exceptional circumstances grant assistance under the Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme for this disaster event.

The maximum amount of assistance that may be given to an eligible entity is \$75 000 for primary producers and \$50 000 for Small Business and non-profit organisations.

For Small Business and non-profit organisations \$10 000 of the \$50 000 is not subject to the requirements of Section 18 (3) (Financial evidence for applications) of Schedule 23.

For Primary producers \$10 000 of the \$75 000 is not subject to the requirements of Section 18 (3) (Financial evidence for applications) of Schedule 23.

The closing day for applications in relation to this disaster event is 29 September 2023.
