Schedule 23 Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme

26 March 2026

AMENDED ASSISTANCE ESTABLISHMENT NOTICE

In accordance with Part 2 of Schedule 23 the Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme is established for the disaster event:

- Queensland Monsoon Trough, Cyclone Koji, Cyclone Narelle and Severe Weather commencing 24 December 2025

Primary producers, small businesses, non-profit organisations are the entities eligible for exceptional circumstances grant assistance under the Special Disaster Assistance Recovery Grants Scheme for this disaster event.

The maximum amount of assistance that may be given to an eligible primary producer is \$75,000.

The maximum amount of assistance that may be given to an eligible small business entity is \$50,000.

The maximum amount of assistance that may be given to an eligible non-profit organisation entity is \$50 000.

For primary producers, up to \$65 000 in expenditure is subject to the requirements under Section 18 (3) (Financial evidence for applications) of Schedule 23.

For small business, up to \$45 000 in expenditure is subject to the requirements under Section 18 (3) (Financial evidence for applications) of Schedule 23.

For non-profit organisations, up to \$45 000 in expenditure is subject to the requirements under Section 18 (3) (Financial evidence for applications) of Schedule 23.

The closing date for applications in relation to this disaster event for primary producers is 6 January 2027.

The closing date for applications in relation to this disaster event for small businesses is 15 January 2027.

The closing date for applications in relation to this disaster event for non-profit organisations is 15 January 2027.
