Eligibility



To be eligible for the assistance you must:

- ✓ be a primary producer in financial difficulty
- ✓ have eligible term debt
- ✓ lack resources to access a similar professional service

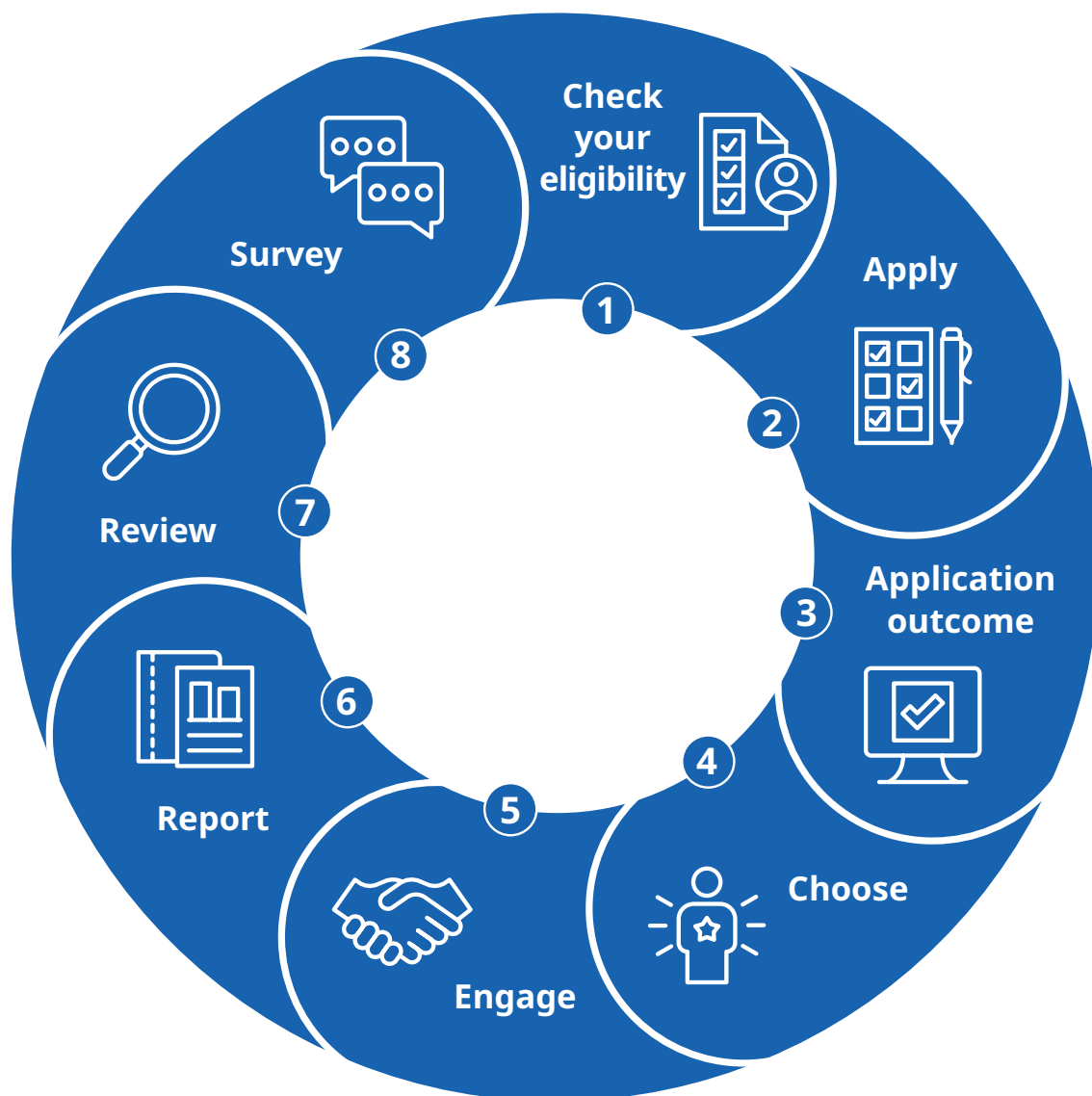

Application process



1

Check your eligibility. Read the guidelines on QRIDA's website and discuss your eligibility for the assistance with QRIDA's Farm Debt Restructure Office.

2

Apply. If you are eligible, submit your completed application with supporting documents to QRIDA. Details on how to apply are on the application form.

3

Application outcome. The Farm Debt Restructure Office will review your application and advise you of the outcome within 20 business days.

4

Choose. If approved, you will be able to review and choose an independent consultant from our panel of providers to carry out the analysis of your business. Please notify QRIDA of your chosen consultant.

5

Engage. You will engage with your chosen consultant over a period of eight weeks to help them understand your situation. Documents may be required from your financier and accountant.

6

Report. The consultant will provide an impartial report outlining options and recommendations for your business.

7

Review. You review the options and recommendations provided in the report and decide what actions you want to take and whether you want to share the report with your bank manager and financier.

8

Survey. At the end of your experience QRIDA will ask you to complete a survey to ensure we are maintaining quality service.
